

MOOSE PETERSON'S PHOTO ADVENTURE CHECKLIST



- Do your homework and create a visual idea file of images for where you are traveling you want to take.
- Create written checklists for personal gear and camera gear. Start these lists at least a month prior to your travel.
- If you're going to rent a piece of gear, reserve it well in advance.
- Create a checklist of locations at your destination you want to visit. Fill it full knowing that you won't make it to all of them.
- Make sure you have batteries, chargers and cards for all the bodies you're taking.
- Make sure you have card readers for the cards you're taking.
- Make sure your computer has all the software you desire and it is up to date.
- Install the Nikon Manual Viewer App and load the instruction manuals for your bodies.
- Create and pack a sensor cleaning kit.
- Clean all the front elements and filters prior to leaving.
- Pack a "repair" kit, which includes tweezers, crazy glue, jewelry screwdrivers and pliers.
- Grab gloves, a jacket and shoes appropriate for your adventure.
- Have your tripod, tripod head and all connecting plates needed for all your gear.
- Pack a water bottle, hard candy and energy bars.
- Check the weather for the location of your adventure for comfort and alerts.
- Create, pack and take a small emergency first aid kit.
